

BEACH ACCESS

Q & A

Are Beaches open? You can access the beach on foot and carry your beach gear, however, beaches are closed to vehicular traffic. Bikes without motors are allowed, all other motorized vehicles are not permitted.

Where can I park if going to the beach? Parking will be extremely limited. If walkable, walk. If you must drive, you will most likely have to park on the street side (if available). Do not illegally park, you will be ticketed and possibly towed.

Is there a curfew? Yes, there's a curfew on the beach at night. Beaches will close every night starting Thursday, July 16th at 8:30 p.m. thru 6:00 a.m. on Monday, August 17, 2020. You must be off the beach between 8:30 p.m. and 6:00 am.

Is there a limit on group gatherings? As per Governor Abbott's Executive Order GA-28, any outdoor gathering in excess of 10 is prohibited.

Can I overnight camp on the beach? No, there is a beach curfew in effect.

Are bars open? No, they are closed per Governor's order.

Are restaurants closed? They are open, but have reduced seating per Governor's order.

Are masks required? Yes, all commercial establishments require a mask to enter. You don't have to wear it while outside.

Is ADA access permitted? Yes, upon presenting proper documentation. (A handicap parking placard or plate.) ADA entrance is located at Access Road 1A.
