All bids must be clearly marked "**SEALED BID** – **RFP 2023-07 - 2023 Municipal Marina Repairs**" to the City of Port Aransas City Secretary's office, 710 W. Avenue A, Port Aransas, Texas prior to Thursday, May 25, 2023, at 3:00 pm, at which time they will be publicly opened and acknowledged in the City Hall Council Chamber. Any bid delivered or received after 3:00 pm will not be considered and shall be returned unopened to the addressee. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

This project consists of <u>demolition and reconstruction of wooden docks</u>, <u>bulkhead cap</u>, <u>and</u> sidewalk.

Bidders must submit a Cashier's or Certified Check issued by a bank satisfactory to the City of Port Aransas, payable to the City of Port Aransas in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the bid submitted as a guaranty that the Bidder will enter a contract using the forms provided within ten (10) days after notice of award of contract to him.
