TROPICAL STORM BERYL Advisory 2 – 2:00 p.m.

Mayor Moore and the City of Port Aransas Emergency Management Team continue to monitor Tropical Storm Beryl.

The Coastal Bend region is currently under a hurricane watch, with a possible Category 2 hurricane making landfall in the area early Monday morning. The first impacts will be coastal flooding and a storm surge in the 3'-5' range, hitting mid-day on Sunday. Heavy rainfall of 5"-10"+ may fall in certain areas. Tropical storm winds are expected to arrive late Sunday night. Tropical Storm Beryl is projected to restrengthen into a hurricane by early Sunday.

Mayor Moore has issued a mandatory evacuation order for all visitors to evacuate Port Aransas by Sunday, July 7, 2024, by 12:00 p.m. This order excludes Port Aransas residents and property owners.

All residents and rental companies are asked to keep their trash toters in a secure location and not set them out on the curb as Monday trash service has been suspended. The City of Port Aransas anticipates no other interruptions to utility services.
