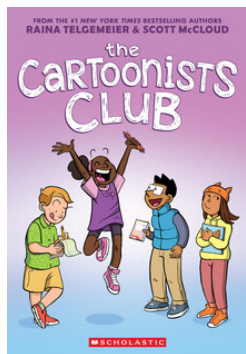

Millions of people across the country visit their libraries every week. What's the Draw? Everything! From young families stopping in for play and storytime, to students sketching out their next creative project in a



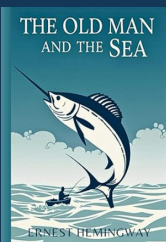

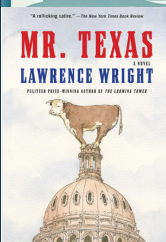

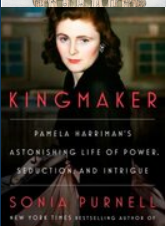
