1. Section 8 “Contract Requirements”, subsection 8.11 “Non-Exclusive Contract” (page 14 of RFQ pdf). Does the City anticipate a contract award to a single firm or to multiple firms? **Single Firm**
2. Subsection 8.3 “Contract Term and Agreement” and “8.5. Notice to Proceed” (page 12 of RFQ pdf). If multiple awards, please provide additional clarification regarding activation of contract services (e.g. assignment of task orders, rotation among multiple selected firms, or project-specific selection)? **Being awarded to single firm**
3. Section 5.8 “SECTION 8: PROPOSED PRICING (1 Page limit)” (page 5 of RFQ pdf)), ... The Respondent with the lowest average proposed base rate shall receive the maximum points possible. How is the Cost Proposal form (Attachment H) intended to align with the pricing requirements Should the proposer submit base rates used for evaluation purposes or fully loaded billing rates (including base rate, overhead, profit)? **Rates should be all-inclusive.**
4. Attachment H: Cost Proposal Form” (page 23 of RFQ pdf), some Categories do not directly align with the Scope of Work, may not reflect a typical FEMA recovery contract approach and/or positions may typically perform dual roles not separate titles. For example, a) Construction is not a named SOW item, b) firms may not need five separate Program Management roles or c) a Project Manager may also be the FEMA Liaison. **If someone is filling dual roles, then their name can be on both position lines.**
 - a. Are the categories and positions on Attachment for comparison in evaluation purposes only? Or, **Yes**
 - b. Given Section 5.8 “SECTION 8: PROPOSED PRICING (1 Page limit)” (page 5 of RFQ pdf)), “All positions that may perform any work required under the scope of services should be included in this rate sheet.” Should submitting firms modify Attachment H to align with the positions they have proposed in the organization chart so that they reflect the proposed positions and staff that may perform the work? **Positions you list on the organizational chart should match and the staff names on those positions on the org chart and Attachment H should match.**
