CITY OF PORT ARANSAS



Mobile Food Vendors must provide the required parking spaces based on their type of operation and number of seats available.



BASE PARKING REQUIREMENTS

(Up to 18' Long)

LARGE MOBILE FOOD VENDORS
(Over 18' Long)

PUSH CARTS

1.0

A Type I Mobile Food Vendor may be treated as a push cart when the scale and operational characteristics are comparable, as determined by the Administrator.



ADMINISTRATOR AUTHORITY

The Administrator may require additional parking spaces based on operational characteristics, including:



Number of service windows



Walk-up ordering areas



Drive-up service



On-site customer congregation areas



Site layout



Additional parking may also be required for customer-use areas without seating, consistent with the treatment of similar areas for restaurant uses.



PARKING MUST REMAIN AVAILABLE



Required spaces must be:

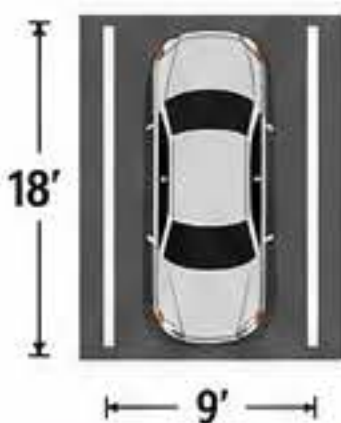
- ✓ Open
- ✓ Striped or clearly marked
- ✓ Accessible at all times

Spaces cannot be blocked by:

- ✗ Food trucks
- ✗ Tables or seating
- ✗ Lines or queues
- ✗ Equipment



GENERAL PARKING STANDARDS



- Standard parking space: 9 ft x 18 ft
- Must be properly surfaced and drained
- Must be accessible from a driveway
- Must maintain safe traffic circulation
 - Vehicles should not back into public streets
 - Drive aisles must remain clear and unobstructed

COMPLIANT PARKING (HEAD-IN PARKING)



Spaces are open, clearly marked, and easily accessible.

NON-COMPLIANT PARKING



Spaces are blocked or unavailable. This is not allowed.

NOT ALLOWED



Blocking required parking spaces



Using public streets to meet parking requirements



Creating unsafe traffic conditions



Operating without approved City authorization
