



WIND-RESISTANT TRASH CONTAINERS

MOBILE FOOD VENDOR REQUIREMENTS



Help keep Port Aransas clean, safe, and beautiful.

All mobile food vendors must use wind-resistant trash containers that prevent litter from blowing away.

CONTAINERS MUST HAVE:

- ✓ Secure openings (no removable lids)
- ✓ Heavy-duty, all-weather construction
- ✓ Tip-resistant or anchored design
- ✓ Ability to withstand coastal winds
- ✓ Minimum size: 40 gallons



ACCEPTABLE EXAMPLES

SQUARE STEEL RECEPTACLE WITH HOOD



Heavy steel construction with integrated weather hood prevents blowout and keeps litter contained.

DOMESTOP STEEL RECEPTACLE



Weighted steel design with enclosed dome top keeps trash secure in high winds.

SLATTED STEEL RECEPTACLE WITH HOOD



Durable slatted steel with protective hood opening is built for outdoor, coastal use.

CONCRETE RECEPTACLE WITH HOOD



Heavy concrete construction provides maximum stability and wind resistance.

ALL-WEATHER RESIN RECEPTACLE



Impact-resistant resin with integrated opening is rust-proof and built to last.

MODERN STEEL RECEPTACLE WITH HOOD



Modern design with secure opening and heavy steel build stands up to wind and weather.

★ WIND-RESISTANT TRASH CONTAINERS MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 40 GALLONS.

NOT ACCEPTABLE



Open top containers



Lightweight plastic cans



Loose bags or bins



Containers with removable lids

These options can tip over, blow open, or scatter trash in the wind.



RECOMMENDED SETUP



Place within 10 feet of your service window.



Use a wind-resistant container with a secure opening.



Consider adding weight or securing in a stable area.



WHY IT MATTERS

Strong coastal winds can scatter litter, harm our environment, and impact our community. Using the right trash container helps us all keep Port Aransas clean.
